Trends

A local vagrant who is known to be involved with house breaking, theft out of motor vehicle and theft in general has been seen around the MID more regularly.

Safety & Security TIPS:

- Do not leave any valuables in vehicles and ensure vehicles are locked.
- ➤ Do not leave any valuables near open windows at home, especially when considering that many buildings are on the sidewalk perimeter.
- Criminals are opportunistic, be aware of your surroundings.
