

## **Public Safety & Security: 18-24 May 2015**

### **Incidents of Crime:**

- **19/05/2015**  
At around 00.53 the patrollers found 4 males in Holland Rd. They were searched and the patrollers found screwdrivers and pliers on them. The items were removed from them and they were escorted out of the area.
- **19/05/2015**  
At 02.40 the patrollers found 3 males near False Bay station. They were searched and items such as a screwdriver and knife were removed and they were escorted out of the area.
- **21/5/2015**  
At around 23.15 Control spotted on camera 2 suspicious males in Palmer Rd. The patrollers were sent to investigate. They searched the suspects and found a knife on the 1 suspect. They were escorted out of the area.
- **23/05/2015**  
Control received a call from the resident in Hansen Rd. She told control that someone had stolen hubcaps from a vehicle. The patrollers went to check that area but could not find any suspects.
- **24/05/2015**  
Control received a call from a resident saying he found a man in his car. The response vehicle went to investigate and found the man. He had stolen a remote and radio. SAPS were informed and the suspect was detained. The client opened a case.

### **Vagrancy:**

- **18 /05/2015**  
A business owner in Atlantic Road called into the Control Room and asked if the patrollers could please remove the vagrants in front of their business premises. The patrollers removed them.
- **19 /05/2015**  
At around 21.45 Control received a call from a resident at in Royal Rd. They asked for assistance as there was someone in front of their property. The patrollers removed the person out of the area.
- **22 / 5 / 2015**  
At 23.22 a vagrant pushing a trolley in Albertyn Rd was searched and escorted out of the area.

### **Other Observations:**

#### **Hotspots**

- Holland Rd still seems to be a target for theft out of motor vehicle.
- Royal Rd and Alexander Rd.

#### **Trends**

- Theft out of motor vehicles & muggings

- Do not leave any valuables near open windows at home, especially when considering that many buildings are on the sidewalk perimeter.
