

Public Safety & Security: 22 December 2014 – 04 January 2015

Incidents of Crime:

- **23/12/2014**
At around 12.30 it was reported to that a resident's son was robbed in Church Road. He stole money from the boy. The resident was told to open a case at SAPS.
- **28/12/2014**
Control spotted 4 suspects on the camera in Palmer Road stealing from no12 Palmer. The patrollers were sent out with the assistance of the Response they were caught and arrested a case was opened by the client.

Vagrants:

- **24/12/2014**
2 suspicious males removed from Doreena Court in Rhodesia Road.
- **25/12/2015**
A group of youngsters removed from the corner of Lagerchinos they were loud and owner asked for them to be removed.
- **27/12/2015**
Patrollers removed vagrants pushing trollies down Church Road.
- **30/12/2015**
A fight was broken up by the patrollers in Hansen Road at around 3pm.

The proposed security plan for the festive season worked well. Having 4 patrollers separated into for different zones meant that they covered a larger area and were more visible. There were more arrests made and a number of crimes were prevented as the visibility of the patrollers were always seen.

The MID Security bibs also worked very well.

Safety & Security TIPS:

- Do not leave any valuables in vehicles and ensure vehicles are locked.
- Do not leave any valuables near open windows at home, especially when considering that many buildings are on the sidewalk perimeter.
- Criminals are opportunistic, be aware of your surroundings.
