

Public Safety & Security: 26 January – 01 February 2015

Incidents of Crime:

- **27/01/2015**
At around 14.50 the patrollers caught a coloured youngster in Hansen Rd he had stolen a lady's phone on the corner of Alexander & Atlantic road. The victim did not want to open a case the phone was given back and he was taken out of the area. No further details.
- **28/01/2015**
At 07.05 patrollers reported that they found a White Toyota Tazz in Royal Rd. The owner said that his vehicle had been broken into and the items stolen were the radio speakers and the battery. He was told to open a case at SAPS. No further details.
- **29/01/2015**
Our Control room received a call at 08.20 from resident in Atlantic Rd that they had a break in at the upstairs property item stolen Apple Laptop. A case was opened with SAPS.
- **30/01/2015**
Control received a call at 05.50 from a property owner in Cromer Rd that there were 2 men arguing in the street on arrival patrollers found a suspect at a property Cromer Rd he had a screwdriver in his possession. SAPS were informed. No further details.
- **1/02/2015**
Control received a call at 05.25 from the resident in Killarney Rd that a Corsa had been broken into. The owner could not be located. SAPS informed. No further details.
