

Public Safety & Security: 27 April – 03 May 2015

Incidents of Crime:

- **30/04/2015**
A fight was spotted on CCTV in Palmer Rd. The complainant has laid a charge at SAPS.
- **01/05/2015**
At 12.50 control received a call from a resident in Cromer Rd. He reported that someone jumped over his wall and stole his phone through the window.
- **01/05/2015**
At 21.14 a resident at Clarendon Court phoned in and reported that someone had broken into a flat. Our patrollers and response checked the area and found 2 coloured males near the Bowling Club. They had stolen a Flat screen TV and a car jack. SAPS were informed and they were taken into custody. No further details.
- **02/05/2015**
At 08.03 our patroller reported that a drain cover had been stolen in Hansen Rd.

Vagrants

- **28/04/2015**
At 02.25 control spotted 2 males on bicycles in Atlantic Rd. The patroller stopped them to enquire about their activities and their response was that they were just cycling around in Muizenberg. They were removed from the area.
- **28/04/2015**
At 03.16 the patrollers saw 2 suspicious coloured males walking down Milner Rd. They were removed out of the area.
- **29/04/2015**
At 03.05 the patrollers removed 2 males and 1 female out of York Rd.
- **29/04/2015**
Our patrollers removed 2 males that came over the foot bridge into the area.
- **01/05/2015**
At 11.33 the patrollers removed 2 men sitting in between the bushes on the corner of Holland and Palmer Rd.
- **5/4/2015**
At 10.55 our 1 Patroller removed vagrants in Palmer Road. The vagrants were caught on camera begging from door to door.

Other Observations:

Hotspots

- Holland Rd has a number of vagrants wandering up and down the street.
- Milner Rd also has vagrants and a few suspicious people wandering in the area.

Trends

- Opportunity crime where people are still leaving valuables in their vehicles.

Safety & Security TIPS:

- Do not leave any valuables in vehicles and ensure vehicles are locked.
- Do not leave any valuables near open windows at home, especially when considering that many buildings are on the sidewalk perimeter.
- Criminals are opportunistic, be aware of your surroundings.
