NOTE

Public safety services in an improvement district are only for public space. The 24-7 public safety patrol service provided to the Muizenberg Improvement District by GRIT is focused on making it safe for people to walk in the streets and enjoy public spaces. This top-up service does not replace the services already provided by the South African Police Services (SAPS), Law Enforcement and Metro Police. Please take note that the MID Public Safety Patrollers are not permitted to enter private property and residents are responsible for their own home security and safety.

That said, GRIT recognizes that what happens in public space affects the entire MID Community. This is why we collaborate closely with MCSI (the Neighborhood Watch) the MID Social Worker, Law Enforcement and SAPS to identify social problems, crime hot spots and trends in the way criminals operate. This helps all of us involved in crime prevention to focus our efforts effectively.

6. Trends and hotspots

Muggings between Muizenberg and St James

Robbers continue to terrorize locals and tourists using the catwalk between Muizenberg Beach and St James. In Sept GRIT assisted in an assault where two muggers were positively identified by the victim who opened a case at SAPS. In October there were another two assaults on the catwalk on the 10th and the 24th. The MID Public Safety Officers work with Neighbourhood Watch groups and the Police, doing surveillance to check if likely criminals come through the MID area. These muggings are very worrying and the Grit management team welcomes the collaborative effort championed by Councilor Kuhl, the MID and other players to deploy two new dedicated Auxiliary Law Enforcement Officers whose focus is patrolling the walkway between Muizenberg and Kalk Bay.
