Restoring Dignity – Advocacy	<ul> <li>Applies to the homeless who engage voluntarily with SDO or Fieldworkers and seek support with facilitating work opportunities to gain experience through job creation at events &amp; NPO activities such as FoMP, Kite Festival &amp; Muizenberg Festival. Ultimate aim is to encourage the individuals off the street and into shelters</li> </ul>
	Identifying Safe Spaces: to sleep at night, to store belongings, ablution facilities, to cook their food, to wash their clothes
Acting on By-Law	<ul> <li>Public Safety Director &amp; Service Provider by alerting SAPS, LE to take action. MID cannot enforce by-laws or take heavy-handed action. MID's role is limited to observing and reporting anti-social behaviour to law enforcement agencies</li> <li>Applies to all homeless. MID will adhere to the Law &amp; Bill of Rights. Only SAPS or LE officers can physically touch, remove, arrest or</li> </ul>
infringements	detain any person. MID Public Safety <u>can only</u> report by-law infringements for public drunkenness, indecency, urinating and defecating in public, littering and disturbance of the peace
Social Support	<ul> <li>The Open Door Social Support Services every Monday 12:30pm – 3:30pm and Thursday 8:30am – 12:30pm at the Muizenberg Clinic Building.</li> <li>Focus on homeless residents (adults and children), but also accessible to the broader community. Includes: referrals to medical/ social services, advice, needs identification, access to grants, IDs, health care, job readiness, support groups.</li> </ul>
	Coordinated by SDO.
Responsible Giving	<ul> <li>MID does not support handouts. MID supports activities that encourage responsible giving through reputable organisations providing services to street people.</li> </ul>

Street children	Cape Street Children's Forum and SAPS – the key to addressing concerns involving day strollers, vulnerable children in need of care and protection, children struggling with addiction and aggressive behaviour towards others.
